

Public Notice

Notice is hereby given that the County of Webb is currently soliciting proposals to donate and/or to purchase a tract of land containing approximately seventy-five (75) to one hundred (100) acres for the construction of the Webb County Jail and Law Enforcement Complex Center. The process to donate, exchange and/or to engage in the sale land for the construction of the Webb County Jail and Law Enforcement Complex Center is contingent upon the recommendations of the Webb County Jail Feasibility Committee and contingent upon the availability of funding sources. The Webb County Commissioner's Court will make final decisions.

The County of Webb will consider proposals based on the following criteria:

1. Acreage
2. Costs associated with acquisition and development.
3. Suitability of property for intended use.
4. Encumbrances
5. Location of property (accessibility for ingress and egress) with regard to the City of Laredo and major thoroughfares.
6. Availability of public utilities including but not limited to water, wastewater electrical and telecommunication services.
7. Environmental and archeological history.
8. Geological make up of the site's soil.

Proposals should include:

1. Certified copy of conveyance instrument evidencing ownership of property.
2. List of all known encumbrances including mineral leases, easements, etc.
3. Description of public utilities and service provider(s) (i.e. water, wastewater, electricity, natural gas, telecommunications and cable). If not applicable, provide distance of nearest provider for each.
4. Price per acre. (Include donation if applicable)
5. Bidder's information
6. Describe the property with topography, drainage, and any special issues regarding flooding or the special flood hazard area;
7. Provide detail with regarding jurisdictional issues related to municipal corporate limits or extra-territorial jurisdictions, if any;
8. Details with regard to plat status.
9. Details with regard to zoning status, if applicable.
10. Tax certificates showing evidence taxes are current for all applicable taxing entities.
11. Property location map.

Sealed proposals must be submitted with one original and nine copies in sealed envelopes to the Offices of the Webb County Clerk. Sealed envelopes must be marked (Sealed Proposals) with bid number and description.
